# MUNDUS RETURNS TO NORTHEAST

## Captain that inspired *JAWS* is booking trips!

This June, renowned shark specialist Capt. Frank Mundus is returning to Montauk, Long Island for the 30th anniversary of the 1975 box office smash, *JAWS*. It is widely known in the sport-fishing community that Mundus, in addition to logging literally countless hours shark fishing, was really the pioneer of big game sharking. A former Brielle, NJ resident, Mundus was the basis for the memorable, weathered shark hunter Captain Quint. The late Robert Shaw portrayed Quint in the motion picture, which has now achieved iconic status. In fact, although both the movie and Peter Benchly's best selling novel are both fictional, much of the exciting and somewhat horrifying

story line was inspired by a combination of Mundus's remarkable experiences, and a series of tragic events.

During the infamous summer of 1916, these tragic events took place in the waters off the New Jersey

Coast. It is at this unforgettable time that a large great white shark stalked several local, beach-resort towns including Spring Lake, Beach Haven and Matawan. Sadly, multiple fatal shark attacks occurred along these beaches. Some years later, in June of 1964 to be precise, a young Captain Mundus took a colossal 4,500-pound great white shark off Montauk Point. Being much too large for conventional tackle, the beast was worn down and taken using

a unique technique that incorporated five empty beer kegs (barrels) that were tethered to as many harpoon darts. Sound familiar? This epic battle was the blueprint for *JAWS* the movie.

Almost exactly 2 years later, in June of 1966, author Peter
